### **Dear participants, welcome!**

We hope you will enjoy your visit to Serbia.

To make your stay here pleasant, here is some important information.

Seminar in Sremski Karlovci (Serbia) gathers NFE practitioners from Finland, Lithuania, Spain, Albania, Kosovo, Croatia, Macedonia and Serbia.

You will be accommodated in the Ecological Centre "Radulovački" in Sremski Karlovci, address Mitropolita Stratimirovica 5, phone +381 (0) 21 881027. Ecological center provides linens and towels, so you do not need to take any of it.

Sremski Karlovci is a town and municipality in Serbia, in the autonomous province of Vojvodina, situated on the bank of the river Danube. The population in 2011 was 8,722. The town has traditionally been known as the area of good vines and historically important places. More info are available here [www.karlovc.org.rs/monuments](http://www.karlovc.org.rs/monuments)

From Belgrade to Sremski Karlovci you can come by bus or train. Traveling by bus lasts approximately 80 minutes. Price of the ticket is about 600 dinars (2,5 Euro). This is a bus timetable from Belgrade to S. Karlovci for 7<sup>th</sup> of June: 04:30, 04:50, 05:15, 05:45, 06:00, 06:50, 07:40, 08:15, 10:00, 10:20, 11:20, 11:45, 12:10, 12:25, 14:30, 15:15, 15:45, 16:00, 17:40, 18:30, 19:20.

For those who come to Belgrade by plane, in additional document you can find the timetable (bus A1) from the airport "Nikola Tesla" to the main intercity bus station. If you arrive at the airport before 07:00, or after 20:30, please let us know. We will find a way how to transfer you to the bus station.

Be sure that you arrive **until the dinner, which is at 20:00 on 7<sup>th</sup> of June**. After dinner at 21:00 we will have some welcome notes and a brief intro to the seminar. If someone comes earlier during the day, of course it is possible to access your rooms in the Ecological Centre. Experience has shown that most of the participants must start traveling early in the morning, so we don't plan some special activities on 16th.

The official currency in Serbia is dinar (RSD). The dinar exchange rate varies. At this moment it is 1 euro = 124 dinars. If you are changing money, be sure to do it only at official exchange offices.

Organizers will cover all costs concerning the training, such as: Accommodation and food, domestic travel costs and training material. We are not able to cover your travel insurance.

Participants **should bring their own laptops**, and are expected to be committed to participate in the whole program. Also be aware that after the training you (with other participants) will **be obligated to deliver the online course (created during the training)**.

For planning you traveling, please keep in mind info about **maximum travel refund (European Commission criteria, total travel costs)**:

- Lithuania: 275 EUR

**If you travel arrangement is such that you have to come a day earlier or stay later, please inform us about that in advance.** Usually we are not able to cover the cost of that additional day.
